Introduction to Test

There are 5 parts to this test. When the instruction line includes the word “listen”, the teacher must read the text to the students. Repeat each item two times. Please note that any text in parentheses is the answer and therefore is not read.

Levels 3 and 4 Placement Test

A. Listen and choose.

1. Where are you going? I’m going to the toy store.
(toy store)
2. What’s he doing? He’s sleeping.
(boy sleeping)
3. Whose gloves are these? They’re my gloves.
(gloves)
4. What time is it? It’s eight fifteen.
(8:15)
5. I have a sore throat.
(girl holding her throat)
6. What did you do today? I played with a friend.
(boy waving to his friend)
7. What does she have to do? She has to sweep the floor.
(girl with broom)
8. What happened? He lost his jacket.
(boy looking for his jacket on the table)

B. Listen. Read and choose.

1. What’s he doing?
(He’s swimming.)
2. Was she tired?
(Yes, she was.)
3. Whose jacket is this?
(It’s her jacket.)
4. Does she have to dry the dishes?
(Yes, she does.)
5. What did they do?
(They played video games.)
6. Is the green one bigger?
(No, it isn’t. It’s smaller.)

C. Write the words.

Tom is a very little boy. He is eight years old. Tom’s friend is Lucy. She is a lot bigger than Tom. They usually play in the park after school. Yesterday they went to the mall.

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D. Read. Answer the questions.

1. Tom (He) is at Lucy's house.
2. They are going to play basketball.
3. They played soccer.
4. Lucy (She) has to take out the garbage.

E. Talk about it.

1. (point to number one and ask) How many robots does he have?
(He has two robots.)
2. (point to number two and ask) What's he doing?
(He's eating.)
3. (point to number three and ask) Did she talk on the phone?
(Yes, she did.)
4. (point to number four and ask) Which one is shorter?
(The pink one is shorter.)
