Introduction to Test

There are 5 parts to this test. When the instruction line includes the word “listen”, the teacher must read the text to the students. Repeat each item two times. Please note that any text in parentheses is the answer and therefore is not read.

Levels 5 and 6 Test

A. Listen and choose.

1. What will they do? They'll go hiking.
(Two girls hiking.)
2. What did she drink? She drank a soda.
(A girl with soda can)
3. Someone was cooking here. You're right.
(Girl in kitchen looking at dirty dishes)
4. Have you ever seen a castle? Yes, I have.
(A castle)
5. Whose CDs are these? They're his.
(Boy with CDs)
6. It's too high to reach.
(Boy trying to reach top of shelf)
7. Has he finished his homework? No, he hasn't.
(Boy doing homework)
8. Why is he going to the library? Because he has to get some books.
(Boy going to the library)

B. Listen. Read and choose.

1. Who's the tallest?
(Mike)
2. Who's the youngest?
(Sarah)
3. Did they play tag yesterday?
(Yes, they did.)
4. Will she go to an amusement park?
(Yes, she will.)
5. Does she like ice skating?
(No, she doesn't.)
6. Has he washed the dishes?
(No, he hasn't.)

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C. Write the words.

Have you ever heard of the Hope Diamond? It is not a ring. It is too big to wear on your finger. It is one of the biggest blue diamonds in the world. It is famous because it is big and beautiful. It came from India many years ago. Now millions of people come to see this beautiful diamond in a museum in Washington, D.C.

D. Answer the questions. Use words from the box.

1. They'll go swimming.
2. He was flying a kite.
3. They like playing football.
4. She should take an umbrella.

E. Talk about it.

1. (Point to number one and ask) Has he finished his book?
(Yes, he has.)
2. (Point to number two and ask) What does she like doing?
(She likes swimming.)
3. (Point to number three and ask) What should he do?
(He should put on his sweater. *Or* He should wear his sweater.)
4. (Point to number four and ask) Whose binoculars are those?
(They're hers.)
