(Page 2) In the woods not far from here, lives a kitten. The kitten's name is Toby. He is a very young cat. One evening, **Toby the kitten wakes up**. He is in a tree in the woods. The sun is going down and it's getting dark. Toby yawns and looks around. **"Oh, no. Where am I?"** says Toby.

(Page 12) Toby walks and walks and walks. The moon and stars are out. Whoosh! What's that? That's a bat.

It has two windows and a door. It looks like Toby's house. It is Toby's house, but where is Toby's mother?
