(Page 2) Today is Saturday. It's a sunny day. **Colin is with his Mom and Dad. They are at the safari park.**

Mom is driving the car. Dad is taking pictures of the animals. Colin is looking at the animals. They are happy. Let's see what's in the safari park.

(Page 14) It's 5 o'clock in the afternoon. **It's time to go home. Colin is happy.** He saw many animals in the safari park. He saw zebras, kangaroos, monkeys, elephants, and lions. **The lions are his favorite animals.** Which is your favorite animal?
