(Page 2) Meet Alice and John. They are brother and sister. Alice and John like to look for things. When something is missing, they look and look and look for it. Today, Alice and John are at home. **"Where is my lion?"** asks John. **"Look, John! It is under the chair,"** says Alice. **"OK. I see it,"** says John. The lion is under the chair.

(Page 10) John is with his father in the kitchen. His father is hungry. He wants to cook something for dinner. **"Where are the eggs?"** he asks. John looks around the kitchen. He sees the eggs. **"They are in the box,"** says John. **"Thank you, John."** The eggs are in the box. How many eggs can you see?

(Page 12) Alice and John are in the living room with their mother. Alice is on the sofa. John is near the TV. Their Mom is looking for her keys. They are not on the sofa and they are not on the table. **"Where are my keys?"** asks Mom. Alice and John are looking for the keys. **"Look Mom. They are over there. They are on the TV,"** says John. Mom is happy. She needs the keys to drive her car.

(Page 14) Alice and her baby sister want to go outside. They want to play in the yard.
