I think Mum needs peanut butter and cheeseburgers.

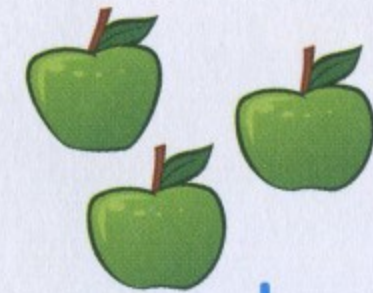
