(Page 2) Dogs are very good pets. **This dog has two puppies.** Puppies are baby dogs. The puppies look like their mother. **They are very cute.** One big dog and two little dogs. Can you see which puppy is listening?

(Page 4) **This is a kitten. A kitten is a baby cat.** Cats and dogs are good family pets. Kittens love to play. This kitten has big eyes, a small mouth and a cute little nose. Do you have a puppy or a kitten?

(Page 6) **This is a mother sheep. She has two lambs.** They are her babies. Lambs are soft and cute. They love to run and jump in the fields. They like to eat green, green grass.

(Page 8) **These are baby rabbits.** These baby rabbits are brown and white. **They have long ears.** Baby rabbits like to hop around and eat vegetables. Do you like to eat vegetables?

(Page 10) **This lion has two cubs.** Cubs are baby lions. They look cute and cuddly but they are not pets. **Lion cubs like to play.** Sometimes they bite their mother's ears and chase her tail.

(Page 12) **This baby gorilla is on his father's back. He loves his father.** Baby gorillas are black and cute. They eat fruit and leaves from trees. Is this baby sleeping? Shhhhhhhh!

(Page 14) Look at the picture. What do you see? **These baby birds are in a tree.** They are baby owls, and they are only a few weeks old. **The baby birds are looking at me.** How many baby owls are sitting in the tree?
